Panna National Park

Panna National Park, nestled in the Vindhyan Ranges of Madhya Pradesh, is a significant tiger reserve and one of the state's five national parks. It is situated approximately 25 kms from the historic town of Khajuraho. Before India's independence in 1947, this area served as a royal hunting ground, known as a "Shikargarh." Recognized for its outstanding maintenance, Panna National Park was awarded the Award of Excellence in 2007 by the Ministry of Tourism of India. The park gained further recognition when it was designated as a Biosphere Reserve on August 25, 2011.
